Sub: Permission matter in Shraddha Homoeopathic Medical College Hospital & Research Center, Kondala Zambre TQ Dist-Washim, Maharashtra with intake capacity of 100 seats in UG (BHMS) course for the academic session 2022-23 – regarding

Sir,

As Central Government by notification, constituted a Commission, to be known as the National Commission for Homoeopathy, to exercise the powers conferred upon, and to perform the functions assigned to it, under NCH Act 2020. As per section 59 (2) of NCH Act, 2020, following has been stated:

“Notwithstanding the repeal of the Homoeopathy Central Council Act 1973, the educational and medical standards, requirements and other provisions of the Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and the rules and regulations made there under shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made there under: Provided that anything done or any action taken as regards the educational and medical standards and requirements under the enactment under repeal and the rules and regulations made there under shall be deemed to have been done or taken under the corresponding provision of this Act and shall continue in force accordingly unless and until superseded by anything or by any action taken under this Act”.

As per provision in the Act, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy has been constituted with the mandate to grant permission to the existing and new medical institution of Homoeopathy. Accordingly, it is to inform you that all the relevant documents and video submitted by your college in LOP inspection dated 22nd & 23rd June 2022, were examined by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board.

2. On careful consideration of the report, the Medical Assessment and Rating Board has arrived at the following conclusion:-

That the applicant has set up a New Homoeopathic Medical College with the component of staff, infrastructure, equipment and instruments and other facilities where as the College has to take urgent and time bound steps to implement Minimum Standard Requirements of the Homoeopathy College and attached Hospital as prescribed by the National Commission for Homoeopathy for conducting BHMS course in Homoeopathy.

On the basis of deficiencies during LOP inspection, college has been given a opportunity of virtual hearing conducted by MARBH held on date 19.07.2022, for further decision. On consideration of the hearing report and annexures, Medical Assessment and Rating Board has observed few deficiencies which are as follows:-

A. TEACHING FACULTY:

- The College has provided list of 12 Full time faculty but Supportive previous documents of 02 faculties are not provided namely:-
A) Dr. Sayyad Shakil Chand Ahmad (Associate .Professor in department of Organon Of Medicine),
B) Dr. Pandurang Tulsiram Dhande DHMS, Reader- Homoeopathic Materia Medica.
- The list of modern medicine consultants with their appointment letter and documents are provided but joining is not provided.

- The names of two guest faculty readers are provided but previous experience as lecturer, appointment and joining not provided.

- B. LIBRARY:** Mr. Akshay Khandare is appointed but joining letter is not provided.
- C. HOSPITAL STAFF :** OPD Data is provided for 22/06/2022 and IPD Data is only provided for 23/06/2022 against the requirement of full 1 year hospital functioning for verification. OPD/IPD data should be provided with the information regarding patients with name, address, age/sex, diagnosis, treatment, admission days in case of IPD may be provided for last 1 year.
- D. WEBSITE –** The college website is functional but hospital information is not updated as checked on dated 01.08.2022.

3. After considering the provisions of section 12C (1) of Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and HCC(MSR) Regulations, 2013, **Permission of the Medical Assessment and Rating Board is issued to Shraddha Homoeopathic Medical College Hospital & Research Center, Kondala Zambre TQ D ist-Washim, Maharashtra with intake capacity of 100 seats in UG (BHMS) course for the academic year 2022-23.** The Principal is directed to fulfill the deficiencies within 30 days and an affidavit in this regard may be submitted to the Medical Assessment Board within a period of one week.

4. All admissions in Under Graduate course shall be through NEET only. It is further informed that, minimum 15% seats of the permitted intake capacity of BHMS course shall be treated as All India quota. The counseling for seats under All India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling Authority of State / UT Government as designated by the Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counseling Authority of that State / UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government for All India quota or the student admitted there under.

5. The category wise list of selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board as per rules.

6. The college has to comply with the full requirements of NCH Act 2020 and relevant regulation for conducting the course. All deficiencies observed, has to be rectified within 30 days' time from the date of issue of this permission letter. Compliance report shall be submitted by the college to Medical Assessment and Rating Board accordingly. Subsequently, the Board shall verify the compliance well in time and may conduct Online/Physical inspection for verification of compliance as per the NCH Act 2020 and relevant regulations.
